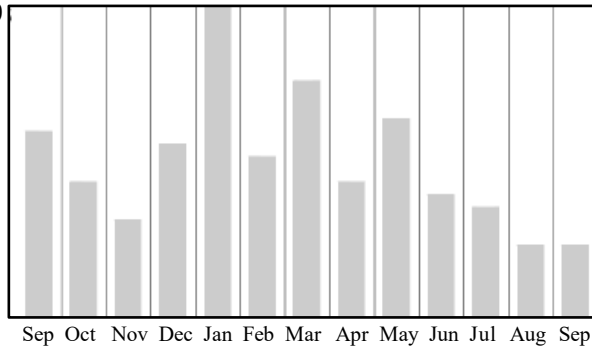

Understanding Your Water Bill

Basic Bill Overview

Each monthly bill shows the total water used, any unpaid balance from previous billing, current charges, and any applicable surcharges. Bills are calculated once per month on the 28th and are due by the 15th of the following month. The water year is based on meter readings, with the October meter reading serving as the final reading of the water year. After this reading, all water allocations reset, and the next meter reading begins a new water year.

Key Sections on the Bill

- 1.) The Top Section states your account number, name and service address, as well as the dates that the meter was read. This is the current billing period of the bill.
- 2.) The Bottom Section is the stub that you return with your payment. This section lists your account number, service address, mailing address, and the amount due.
- 3.) On the left side of the Middle section of the bill, there is a graph that indicates your usage trend over a 12-month period.
- 4.) To the right side of the Middle section, we list your Water Class and Plant Investment Class information. Taps in the District have varying levels of allocation (Yearly allotment amount per water year) depending on how they were purchased or added over time.

Monthly Potable Service Rate

Base Rate (0-6,000 Gals) \$31.14 Flat Rate
 6,001 + Gallons \$5.19 Per 1,000 Gals

Monthly Non-Potable Service Rate

1,000 + Gals \$1.50 Per 1,000 Gals

Understanding Allocation and Surcharges

Each account has a yearly allocation, determined by the Water and Plant Investment Class. If usage exceeds this limit, surcharges will continuously apply until the last meter reading in October.

- Allocation Surcharge (Usage exceeds the YTD water allocation amount) \$6.50 Per 1,000 Gals
- Plant Investment Surcharge (Usage exceeds the YTD PI allocation) \$4.50 Per 1,000Gals
- Residential Meter Overuse Surcharge (Any Customer with a residential water tap that exceeds their water allotment by 3 Acre- feet shall require to pay an enhanced surcharge) \$22.00 Per 1,000 Gals
